

Kleefisch campaign: Fights for women in sports on the 50th anniversary of Title IX

[Waukesha, Wis.] — On the 50th anniversary of Title IX, in the middle of an assault on biological facts by liberal activists in sports, candidate for governor Rebecca Kleefisch released the following statement:
