

Kornblum campaign: Candidate forum scheduled in District 2 Court of Appeals race

Judge Lori Kornblum, the incumbent judge in District 2 of the Wisconsin Court of Appeals and her opponent are scheduled to appear at a candidate forum on Wednesday, March 23 at 12 noon.
