Germantown, WI – Beginning April 15th, the community can purchase locally grown plants including trees, shrubs, conifers, perennials and grasses online and support a Courtyard Improvement Project at Germantown High School. The community-led project is being spearheaded by Leadership Germantown after Environmental Science Teacher and Environmental Club Liasion, Mark McCellan, took the initiative to look to utilize blighted courtyard space for a Greenhouse.

“My students are excited about the idea to have outdoor space we can use for learning and promoting healthy eating. We started talking about the idea and fundraising in the community but realized that the project was a bit complicated for students to tackle alone,” said McCellan. “That’s when the idea to engage the community through Leadership Germantown to help us surfaced. This year, a master plan was completed that would address code compliance issues, access to the courtyard, the landscape and we hope eventually, the greenhouse.”

Chad Johnson, owner of Johnson’s Nursery, was compelled by the project when approached by Leadership Germantown about a plant sale. The plant sale through
