

# League of Wisconsin Municipalities: Kardoskee Appointed to League of Wisconsin Municipalities Board

Mary Kardoskee, the long-serving Village President for the Village of Ashwaubenon was appointed to the League of Wisconsin Municipalities Board of Directors bringing her experience in local government to the statewide governing body.
