Menomonie, WI—Today, Deb McGrath announced raising over \$233,000 in the first seven weeks of launching her campaign for Wisconsin's third congressional District. After amassing \$100,000 within the first 24 hours of launching her campaign, McGrath built on this momentum to average over \$4,480 raised each day. She enters the election year with over \$217,000 cash on hand.
