Bronzeville Week, an official City of Milwaukee event now in its 11th year, officially kicks off this weekend with a variety of events. The inaugural event of Bronzeville Week is the **HaRUNbee 5K Run/Walk for Healthy Birth Outcomes**. Opening day will be capped off with the **Summer Blues and Jazz Concert Series Finale** from 1 – 6 p.m. The finale of the community concert series is hosted by Bader Philanthropies and Northcott Neighborhood House and will occur at 2640 N. 6th St.

On Sunday, August 7 the **Bronzeville Cultural & Arts Festival** takes center stage from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on North Ave. from King Dr. to 7th St. The festival will feature a variety of local vendors, food, three stages with live entertainment and a kid's zone, among other happenings.
