

Milwaukee Press Club: Gov. Tony Evers to headline Newsmaker Luncheon at Rotary

MILWAUKEE – Gov. Tony Evers will be the featured guest at a Newsmaker Luncheon set for noon on Tuesday, October 11, hosted by the [Milwaukee Press Club](#), [WisPolitics.com](#) and [Rotary Club of Milwaukee](#). The event will be held at the Milwaukee Country War Memorial Center, 750 N Lincoln Memorial Drive.

Evers is seeking election to a second four-year term as Wisconsin's governor, and is opposed by Republican businessman Tim Michels. [The Michels campaign has not responded to an invitation to be the featured guest at a Newsmaker Luncheon prior to the General Election November 8.]

Evers will take questions from a panel of journalists and from the audience at the luncheon, to be moderated by Milwaukee Press Club Past President Corrinne Hess, reporter for the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*.
