MILWAUKEE – Tarik Moody of 88Nine Radio Milwaukee will be the featured guest at a Newsmaker Luncheon set for noon on Wednesday, August 3, hosted by the [Milwaukee Press Club](#) and [WisPolitics.com](#).

Moody is content producer and on-air host at 88Nine Radio and program director for HYFIN, the firm's new Urban Alternative channel. With its mix of 60 percent female and 40 percent male artists, HYFIN is a new Urban Alternative channel, a locally customized public radio format focused on young, diverse audiences through the full spectrum of Black music, according to a statement issued at its launch last month. The Corporation for Public Broadcasting is providing initial support for HYFIN with a \$450,000 grant.

The new channel will play music from at least two Milwaukee musicians each hour; and HYFIN's "The Morning Mix" show will be unhosted, playing all music from 6 a.m. to noon.

Moody will take questions from a panel of journalists and from the audience at the luncheon, to be moderated by Milwaukee Press Club President Corrinne Hess, reporter for the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*. The event is set for 11:45 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Newsroom Pub, 137 E. Wells St.
