

Nelson Campaign: Calls out Mandela Barnes for adopting Trump immigration stance

Appleton, Wis. – Outagamie County Executive and U.S. Senate candidate Tom Nelson is calling out Lieutenant Governor Mandela Barnes for supporting Trump and Stephen Miller position on Title 42 immigration and asylum policy. Barnes told the [Milwaukee Journal Sentinel](#) he would not support the lifting of Title 42.

Nelson said in response:
