**Washington, D.C.** -Today, NRSC Chairman Rick Scott announced Operación ¡Vamos! has contacted over 1.4 million Hispanic voters across nine states. “Operación ¡Vamos!”, a seven-figure investment in Hispanic field and communications program began in April of this year. The program has enabled the NRSC, RNC and state parties to share the Republican message with voters in key battleground states for the midterm election.
