MILWAUKEE, WI – Port Milwaukee Director Adam Tindall-Schlicht has informed Mayor Cavalier Johnson of his acceptance of a position in the Biden-Harris Administration. Mr. Tindall-Schlicht's last day at the Port will be Friday, October 28, 2022.

"Serving the residents of the City of Milwaukee and promoting statewide economic growth through the Port's commercial, recreational and cruise operations has been a privilege."

Mr. Tindall-Schlicht has served as Director of Port Milwaukee since August 2018. An interim Port Director will be announced in the weeks ahead. A nationwide search will soon commence to identify a permanent replacement for Milwaukee's Port Director.
