At all three events, residents will be able to:

- Learn about and sign up for City programs and services;
- Apply for City jobs and learn about careers with the City’s many departments;
- Apply for the City’s new summer youth jobs program;
- Talk directly with City staff and staff from partnering organizations about City

programs, services, and resources; and

- Enjoy snacks, kids' activities, bounce houses, and giveaways; enter to win raffle prizes; and obtain free resources.
