

Rep. Allen: Asks if Attorney General Josh Kaul was aware

Madison, WI – Today, Rep. Allen mailed a letter to Attorney General Josh Kaul asking him to confirm or deny his awareness of the alleged illegal activities of spying on former President Trump as revealed in the filings of Special Counsel John Durham.

Specifically, the filings disclose that Michael Sussman and Marc Elias were allegedly involved, and they both have ties to Perkins Coie LLC. Michael Sussman has also been indicted for concealing his part in working for Hillary Clinton's campaign. These activities took place during the time that AG Kaul was employed by Perkins Coie.

Rep. Allen stated, "These allegations, if true, are concerning. The people of Wisconsin deserve to know whether or not their Attorney General was aware of these allegedly illegal activities, and this letter invites Attorney General Kaul to honestly answer the question."
