MADISON - Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly [voted on](#) multiple GOP gun bills ([AB 498](#), [AB 495](#), [AB 518](#), [AB 597](#)). Rep. Jodi Emerson (D-Eau Claire) released the following statement in response:
