Madison, Wis. – Representative Rick Gundrum (R-Slinger) has been appointed to serve as Chair of the Assembly Committee on Jobs, Economy and Small Business Development. After his appointment was announced, he released the following statement:

“I am honored to be appointed to serve as Chair of the Assembly Committee on Jobs, Economy and Small Business Development. Representative Gundrum will serve as a member of that committee, as well as on the Committee on Children and Families, Committee on Local Government, Committee on Mental Health and Substance Abuse Prevention, and the Committee on Workforce Development and Economic Opportunities.
