

Rep. Neubauer: Celebrates affirmation of RUSD referendum passage

MADISON, Wis. — Today, the Wisconsin State Supreme Court handed down their decision to uphold Racine's 2020 school referendum as passed by Racine voters. Assembly Democratic Leader Greta Neubauer (D-Racine) released the following statement in response:

“After engaging in this effort from the beginning, I am thrilled the Wisconsin Supreme Court has ruled in favor of our public schools. This referendum will provide necessary resources and support students to succeed.
