

# Rep. Shelton: Applauds federal bipartisan spending bill

GREEN BAY – Following the Senate’s passage of a bipartisan omnibus spending bill on Thursday, March 10th, State Rep Kristina Shelton (D – Green Bay) celebrated Senator Tammy Baldwin’s commitments to Wisconsin in securing federal funding for multiple projects in the state totaling over \$187 million.
