

# Reps. Moore, Chu, Schakowsky, Katko: Lead bipartisan call for full funding of VAWA programs

In a letter to the House Appropriations Committee, Representatives Gwen Moore, Jan Schakowsky, Judy Chu, and John Katko, called for \$1.135 billion in FY 2023 funding for VAWA programs.
