

RSLC Statement: Voters give Wisconsin Republicans a supermajority in State Senate in clear mandate for conservative leadership

In a clear mandate for conservative leadership, the people of Wisconsin last night voted to give Republicans a supermajority in the state Senate. Last night's results are a major setback for Democrats in Wisconsin and their socialist agenda.
