MADISON – Today, Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) issued the following statement relating to Governor Tony Evers' proposal to spend \$1.7 billion from the projected state surplus:

“Senate Republicans will not gamble with a projected state surplus to fund Tony Evers' re-election gimmicks.

“Governor Evers currently has \$930 million in federal ‘Biden bucks’ at his sole discretion, and he will get another \$1.25 billion in May.
