

Sen. Stroebel: Appointed to senate committees

Madison, Wis. – Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) announced his appointments of all Senate Republicans to the various committees yesterday. Senator Duey Stroebel (R-Cedarburg) was appointed to the Joint Committee on Finance (JFC), Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules (JCRAR), Education, and Chairman of Government Operations, Elections & Consumer Protection. Senator Stroebel issued the following statement:

“I am excited to get to work on behalf of the people of the 20th Senate District next session. With a significant budget surplus projected, and divided government, strong conservative voices on JFC is as important as ever.
