**MADISON, WI** — Wisconsin State Senator Eric Wimberger (R-Green Bay) issued the following statement regarding Governor Evers' claims PFAS Progress Report:

"Governor Evers' PFAS action plan focuses primarily on what he calls 'environmental justice,' which takes into account a person's race to determine how the State will handle pollution issues.
