

Testin campaign: ICYMI, GOP Lt. Gov. candidate Testin named third most conservative State Senator by CPAC/ACUF

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STEVENS POINT, Wis. — On Wednesday, the CPAC Foundation's Center for Legislative Accountability and the American Conservative Union Foundation released their annual scorecard of Wisconsin lawmakers for the legislator's votes during 2021 in the current session.

In the organizations' rankings, Sen. Patrick Testin, Republican candidate for Lieutenant Governor, received a conservative rating of 91% based on his votes in 2021. This rating ranked him as the third most conservative member of the Wisconsin State Senate, and led him to receive CPAC's 2021 Award for Conservative Excellence. Furthermore, he received a lifetime conservative rating of 94%.
