[Fond du Lac, WI...] Fond Du Lac District Attorney Eric Toney, Law Enforcement's Choice for Attorney General, issued the following statement in reaction to the United States Supreme Court's rulings in Maine and New York: "This week's rulings by the United States Supreme Court give parents more education options and upholds law abiding citizens 2nd Amendment rights are a victory for the rule of law and liberty. While extreme liberals like Josh Kaul and Tony Evers are content to trap students in failing schools while the Woke Mob attempts to Defund the Police I will not stand idle as our constitutional rights remain under attack.
