[Fond du Lac, WI...] Fond Du Lac District Attorney Eric Toney, law enforcement's choice for Attorney General, issued the following statement on Josh Kaul's loss in today's Supreme Court ruling: "One year after I called on Josh Kaul to dismiss his frivolous attempt to remove Dr. Prehn from the DNR Board, the Wisconsin Supreme Court agreed saying Kaul was wrong on the law and dismissed Kaul's lawsuit.
