

U.S. Rep. Fitzgerald: Statement on Durham Investigation into Clinton Campaign

WASHINGTON, DC – Today, Congressman Scott Fitzgerald (WI-05) issued the following statement after it was [revealed](#) by Special Counsel John Durham that the Clinton campaign paid a technology company to “infiltrate” servers at Trump Tower and the White House in order to establish a false link between former President Donald Trump and Russia.

*“The Clinton Campaign’s complicity in the Russian hoax can no longer be ignored,” **said Congressman Fitzgerald.** “Special Counsel John Durham’s filing last week reveals exactly how far the Clinton’s went to orchestrate a false link between Donald Trump and Russia by paying a technology company to infiltrate the White House and spy on a sitting president. These new findings are serious and deserve exacting consequences for all those involved.”*
