

# U.S. Rep. Gallagher: Joins delegation in demanding investigation into arson at Wisconsin Family Action office

WASHINGTON, D.C.- Rep. Mike Gallagher (R-WI) joined Reps. Scott Fitzgerald (R-WI), Glenn Grothman (R-WI), Bryan Steil (R-WI), and Tom Tiffany (R-WI) in sending a letter to U.S. Attorney General Merrick Garland demanding an investigation into the arson of Wisconsin Family Action's office in Madison.

In part, the lawmakers wrote, "We condemn acts of violence and intimidation by pro-abortion extremists and demand the Department continue to support state and local law enforcement to prevent similar acts in our country."

On May 8, 2022, two Molotov cocktails were thrown at and into the Family Action office in Madison and a message was spray-painted on the exterior of the building, stating: "if abortions aren't safe then you aren't either."
