

# U.S. Rep. Tiffany: Tapped to serve on China Legislation Conference Committee

**WASHINGTON, DC** – Today, Congressman Tom Tiffany (WI-07), a member of the House Judiciary Committee, was appointed to serve on the [House-Senate Conference Committee](#) for legislation pertaining to Communist China. The Conference Committee is tasked with holding the Chinese Communist Party accountable for their widespread theft of U.S. intellectual property, academic and economic espionage, cover-up of COVID-19, and gross human rights abuses, including slavery and genocide.

“It’s an honor to represent the House Judiciary Committee in this conference, and I’m grateful to Leader McCarthy for his commitment to holding Communist China accountable,” **said Congressman Tiffany.**
