WASHINGTON – Following the 2021 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship victory by the University of Wisconsin-Madison and the 2021 NCAA Division III Women's Volleyball Championship victory by the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire, Sens. Johnson and Baldwin congratulated the teams with resolutions celebrating their championship winning seasons.

Resolved, That the Senate congratulates the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire Blugolds on winning the 2021 National Collegiate Athletic Association Division III Women's Volleyball Championship,” **the UW-Eau Claire resolution read in part.**
