Members may also choose to tour local businesses, breweries or wineries.

The impressive line-up of LLI courses is put together by volunteer members serving

on curriculum committees in each UW-Green Bay campus location: Green Bay, Manitowoc/Sheboygan and Marinette. They are inspired by what's happening in the world, what's trending and what interests are emerging for members.

Members can mix and match formats and enjoy the quality classes LLI is known for, a quality reflected in LLI instructors, who represent UW-Green Bay faculty and expert enthusiasts in the community.
