MILWAUKEE —Thirty-six members of the Wisconsin LGBT Chamber of Commerce received a score of 100 and the distinction of being named one of the “Best Places to Work for LGBTQ+ Equality” on the *2022 Corporate Equality Index* compiled by the Human Rights Campaign (HRC) Foundation. This is an increase from 27 members who received a perfect score in 2021.
