

WisDems: Democrats deliver free masks, tests to keep Wisconsinites safe

MADISON, Wis. – After strong leadership from President Biden and Governor Evers to get Wisconsinites vaccinated against COVID-19, Democrats are continuing to implement overwhelmingly popular strategies to keep the Badger State safe.
