MADISON, Wis. – The [draft Supreme Court opinion](#) that would overturn the decades-long precedent of Roe v. Wade is placing Ron Johnson's vehement anti-choice record back in focus.

Here is Ron Johnson's abysmal anti-choice record:

- When discussing the impact repealing Roe v. Wade would have, Johnson stated: "[I don't view that \[as\] such a huge threat to women's health](#). I think – I think things would be just fine."
- Johnson said if individuals don't like the abortion laws in their state, they simply "[can move.](#)"
- Johnson has advocated for a federal ban on abortion after 20 weeks and signed on to [an amicus brief](#) urging the Supreme Court to uphold Mississippi's law banning abortion after 15 weeks of pregnancy, jeopardizing the reproductive rights of millions across the country.
