

WisDems: Jennifer Dorow gives domestic violence offender opportunity to attack victim's family

MADISON, Wis. — Jennifer Dorow, an extremist and Republican candidate for Wisconsin Supreme Court, let a dangerous criminal loose for two days who had already violated a restraining order.

Following the sentencing of [Michael Liu](#) for *eight counts of domestic violence*, including violation of previous restraining orders, Dorow allowed Liu two days to report to jail. In that time, he broke into the home of his soon-to-be ex-wife's parents and brutally stabbed them.

Dorow, who has already made statements that threaten the rights of the [LGBTQ community](#), cannot be trusted to accept the evidence in front of her, nor to protect victims and those without power under the law.

“Jennifer Dorow’s poor judgment put a victim of domestic violence and their family in direct danger, and our thoughts are with them as they recover from this horrific event,” said **Wisconsin Democratic Party Executive Director Devin Remiker**. “Her decision was disastrous and put a domestic abuser ahead of public safety. This case clearly shows the Republican Party has a lot to learn about Dorow ahead of the primary.”
