MADISON, Wis. - The Supreme Court's decision to overturn Roe v. Wade is in part a result of Republicans' decades-long war against reproductive health. Republican politicians in Wisconsin have now achieved what they've been pushing for years, and the state's 1849 criminal ban could go into effect - even in cases of rape and incest. That means doctors are being threatened with jail time and people's lives are at risk.
