[Madison, Wisconsin] – WISDOM, EX-incarcerated People Organizing (EXPO) and FREE join together to launch the Transformational Justice Campaign on Thursday, December 8th, 2022. The Transformational Justice Campaign promotes policies that:

- prevent people from going to prison
- provide justice within prisons and
- help people returning from prison flourish in the community.

Over 100 leaders from across the state of Wisconsin will come together for a public presentation at 10 a.m. in the North Hearing Room at the Wisconsin State Capitol. WISDOM President Rev. Marian Boyle-Rohloff, EXPO Executive Director Jerome Dilliard, FREE Director Tamra Omran and other campaign leaders will be speaking about several important issues including Solitary Confinement, Treatment Alternatives and Diversions (TAD), Old Law Parole and Post Release Issues. Following the public presentations, members will drop literature at legislative offices as well as the Governor's Office.
