

# WisGOP: April fools! Tony Evers still works for teachers union donors

[Madison, WI] – Wisconsin’s top teachers union, WEAC, has lined Tony Evers’ campaign coffers to the tune of over \$86,000 since his 2018 campaign, and it’s been a worthwhile investment for the liberal group.

While other state governors led on keeping the schools open, vaccines were available, and even Joe Biden [said](#) that students needed to return to the classroom in-person, teachers union bosses made up [new reasons](#) to stay home and Tony Evers was silent – suddenly taking the side of local control after years of pushing for bigger state government.
