

WisGOP: Asks where Tony Evers is as Milwaukee crime rages

[Milwaukee, WI] – Last night, Milwaukee was struck by yet another horrific act of violence as a sheriff's deputy was [shot](#) following a traffic stop. Tragically, this is only the most recent event in a two-year crime spike, as the city once again [set a record](#) for homicides in 2021.
