

WisGOP: Dem Senate candidates statements suggest they oppose any restrictions on abortion

Upon the recently [leaked](#) Supreme Court draft of the Roe v. Wade decision, Wisconsin Democrats have been quick to [make noise](#) about abortion but haven't fully addressed where they stand. Although polling has [shown](#) the majority of Americans support limits on abortion, current statements from the Democrat Senate candidates suggest that they oppose any restrictions:

- Mandela Barnes has [stated](#) that “Politicians have no right to put restrictions on that decision” and that he would vote to codify the right to an abortion nationwide.
