

# WisGOP: Dems unable to control crisis on southern border

In a 5-4 decision today, the Supreme Court [ruled](#) that President Joe Biden has the authority to repeal the Trump administration's "Remain in Mexico" policy, which has been used to limit the flow of migrants and drugs across the porous southern border.
