

# WisGOP: ICYMI: Small business sentiment drops to lowest level since Jan. 2013 as a result of Dems' failed policies

In case you missed it, the National Federation of Independent Business (NFIB) reported that the Small Business Optimism Index dropped 3.6 points in June to 89.5, marking the [lowest level since January 2013](#). Additionally, small businesses owners expecting better business conditions over the next six months decreased to a net negative 61%, the [lowest level ever recorded](#) in their survey.
