

WisGOP: Liberal hacks define “health care” for Tony Evers

[Madison, WI] – While Tony Evers tries to pass off social engineering and big government programs as “health care,” he’s angering actual health care workers to the point of resignation.

Yesterday, the Wisconsin State Journal [reported](#) on Tony Evers and Mandela Barnes’ so-called “Health Equity Council.” The group, which is primarily comprised of Democrat donors, is [calling](#) for government handouts and new taxpayer-funded offices for “environmental justice” and “transgender health and safety” under the banner of “health care.” This comes after Evers’ efforts to impose [government-run health care](#) in his most recent budget.

“The president of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing resigned to protest Gov. Tony Evers’ veto of legislation to allow registered nurses to be licensed as advanced practice nurses.
