

WMC: State's largest business association endorses Rebecca Kleefisch for Governor

GREEN BAY – Wisconsin Manufacturers & Commerce (WMC) – the combined state chamber and manufacturers' association, and the state's largest business association – announced on Monday its endorsement of former Lt. Gov. Rebecca Kleefisch for Wisconsin Governor.
