Tier 2 participants agree to pursue superior environmental performance and maintain an environmental management system. An environmental management system helps companies analyze their environmental impacts, set objectives and targets, develop supporting programs, review results, and allocate resources.

“We are very excited to be officially joining the Green Tier program. After years of hard work by many different people, Northern Engraving Corporation can finally say that they are a Green Tier member,” said Mark Peterson II., the Environmental, Health and Safety Manager for Northern Engraving Corporation. “Being a Tier 2 company on top of it all says a lot about the dedication of the company and its staff in making the protection of the environment a priority.”
