MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers [announced](#) on Feb. 24, 2023, that he is seeking applicants for Marquette County District Attorney. The governor announced today he is extending the application deadline to **5 p.m. on Fri., April 7, 2023.**

The appointment will fill a vacancy created by District Attorney Brian J. Juech's resignation. The new district attorney will serve for the remainder of the unexpired term that ends January 2025.
