MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers announced today that he is seeking applicants for the Milwaukee County Circuit Court - Branches 14 and 46. The appointments will fill vacancies being created by Judge Christopher Foley's resignation, effective July 17, 2023, and Judge David Feiss' resignation, effective July 29, 2023. The new judges will complete a term ending July 31, 2024.
