MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers announced today that he is seeking applicants for the Milwaukee County Circuit Court - Branch 24. The appointment will fill the future vacancy being created by Judge Janet Protasiewicz's resignation to serve on the Wisconsin Supreme Court. The new judge will complete a term ending July 31, 2024.

Applications are currently also being accepted for Branches 14 and 16 of the Milwaukee County Circuit Court.
