Weatherston has had many committee assignments at State level including Chair of aging and long-term health care, Vice chair Workforce Development, Energy and Utilities, Financial Institutions, Transportation, Urban Revitalization, and Veterans and Military Affairs.

As a 46-year resident of Caledonia, Weatherston has enjoyed giving back to his community as a founder of AMVETS Post 262, a Vice President of the Racine Area

Veterans Honor Guard, a Service Officer of the VFW post 10301, and a Member VVA 767. He is married with two adult sons.
