

# Ratcliff campaign: Supervisor Ratcliff will not run for re-election to Dane County Board, endorse Cottage Grove Village Board Trustee David Peterson

Dane County Supervisor Melissa Ratcliff will not run for re-election to the County Board (District 36). She has served on both the County Board and in the State Assembly since being elected to the State Legislature in November 2022. She will continue her public service as a member of the Assembly representing District 46.
