[Madison, WI] – Yesterday evening in the Wisconsin State Assembly Chamber, State Representative Calvin Callahan (R-Tomahawk) and members of the 106th State Assembly were sworn into office for a two-year term. Last November, Rep. Callahan was re-elected to represent the people of the 35th Assembly District. This will be his second term in the Assembly.

“Thank you for trusting me to be your voice down in Madison once again,” stated Rep. Callahan. “I am both honored and humbled to have this opportunity to continue serving my constituents.
